# Better: What Makes Jesus Better?

#### WORD

¹Long ago, at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets, ²but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world. ³He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power. After making purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high, ⁴having become as much superior to angels as the name he has inherited is more excellent than theirs. HEBREWS 1:1-4

The book of Hebrews was written for Christians who needed to look forward with hope for the future. These believers had to know that their present suffering and the persecution they were experiencing would lead to an eternal reward. They may have been tempted to return to their old religious habits. Although they highly respected angels, prophets, and the Law, some may have missed the spirit and design which God had intended for these. The author of Hebrews reminded them that there is one more superior to all of these: Jesus.

Today, in our lives, let's look closely into what makes Jesus the better choice. Beyond any person, religion, or worldview, Jesus is better because He is God's Son and heir, the Creator and sustainer of the world, and the perfect image of God.

## 1 Jesus is God's Son and heir.

... but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed the heir of all things . . . **HEBREWS 1:2** 

Today, an heir has no authority until the ancestor dies and passes it on. However, when the book of Hebrews was written, an heir may be a co-ruler, sharing authority with the reigning monarch. Unlike the rest of mankind, Jesus has a special relationship with God: He is a Son and heir. Jesus Himself has supreme authority. This is why we need to look no further than Jesus. According to this verse, what is Jesus heir of? How can this change the way we view Him and ourselves?
